First off, pick three colors of thread.  
Cut two three-foot pieces of each so  
you'll have six pieces of thread.  
Keep the same colors together!

Then, loop all the string  
around your finger and  
tie two knots.

Tape the loop  
to the table.

Now separate the colors!  
There should be a group of  
colors on each side.

Now the exciting part! Move the  
outside color at the right and cross  
it over to the left on the inside. Then  
take the same color from the left and  
cross it over to the right on the inside.

Now grab the left  
threads in one hand and  
the right threads in  
the other, and tighten!



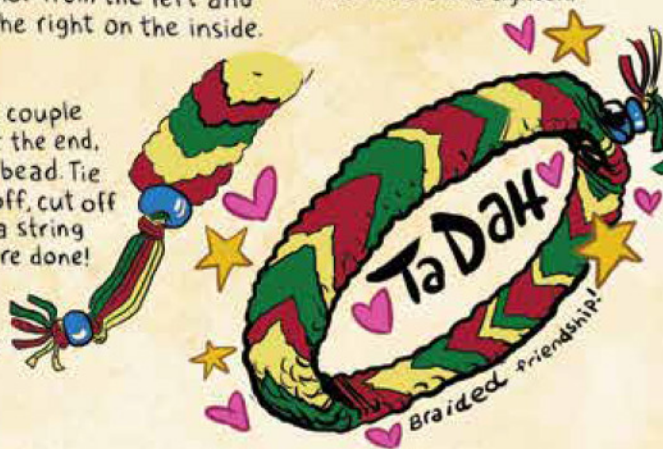

Repeat moving the outside color  
at the right and crossing it over to  
the left on the inside, then taking  
the same color from the left and  
cross it over to the right on the  
inside over and over again.



Now tie a couple  
of knots at the end,  
and add a bead. Tie  
the bead off, cut off  
the extra string  
and you're done!
