From these pataphysical texts we begin to learn more of the culture developed by the FERRIDIANs of the Styxonian Cluster, just outside the Burth System.

Our scans of the sector have identified their species as having peaked approximately 3,000 stellar cycles ago, near or just before The DARK THULU Period. Our gaseous mass analytics has shown considerable fossil record beneath the "rock" of these texts which identify a small, powerful bipedal creature.
