



















## MANDRAKERICANS

LEGENDARY MAGICIAN ANNOUNCES CHARITY GALA FOR EMERGENCY RELIEF FUND



Late last night. Mandrake the Magician, once considered the world's premier illusionist, announced a special one off charity performance to raise money for emergency relief in those areas of the world hit hardest by the recent invasion.
