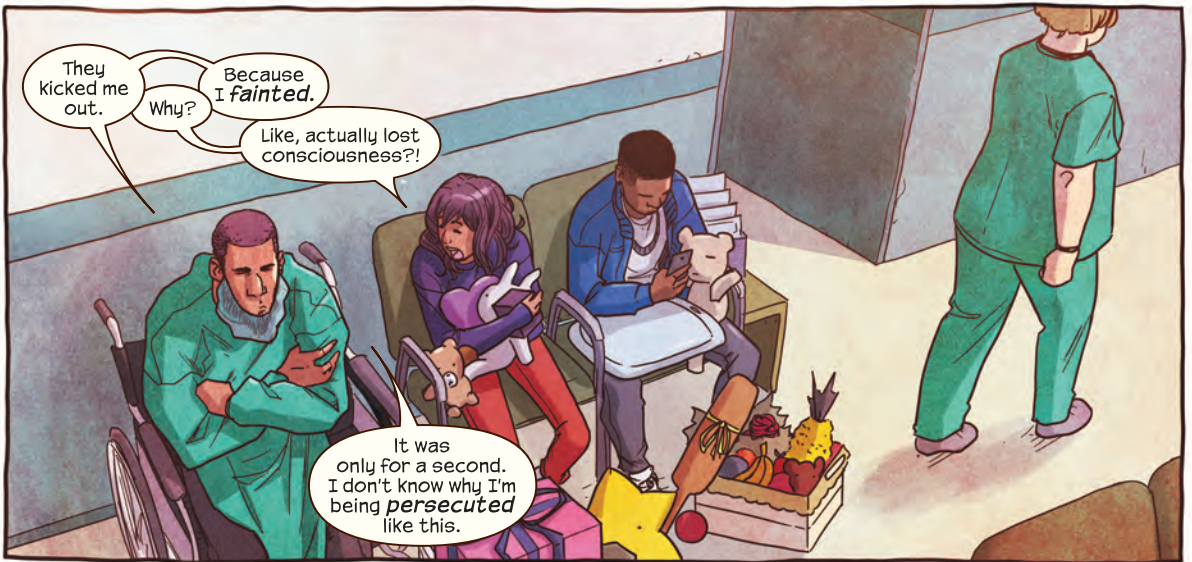

Like, actually lost consciousness?!

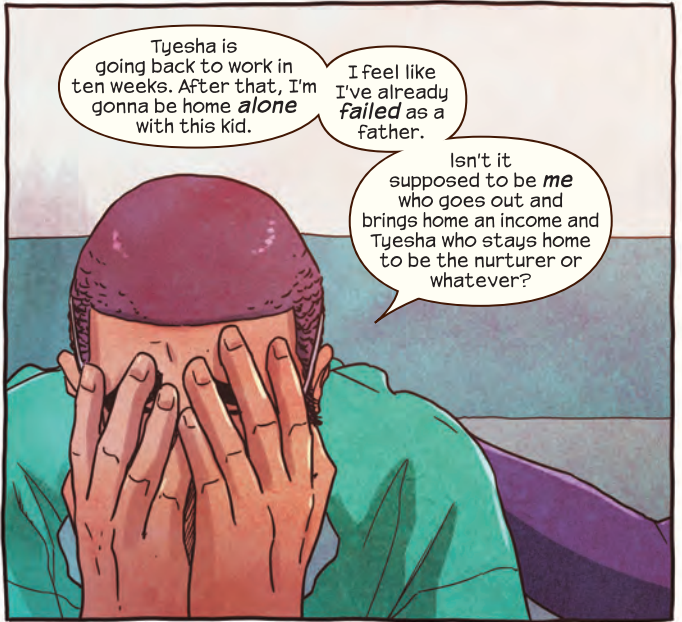
It was only for a second. I don't know why I'm being *persecuted* like this.

Too late now, my good man.

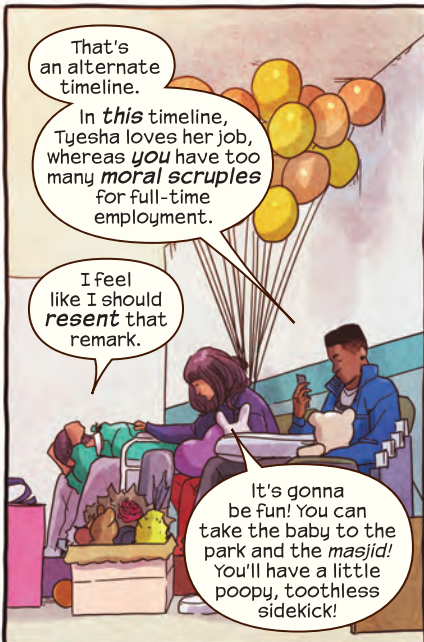
It'll be great! You'll see! Abu was just saying that fatherhood comes with *on-the-job training*.

It's gonna be fun! You can take the baby to the park and the *masjid*! You'll have a little pooppy, toothless sidekick!



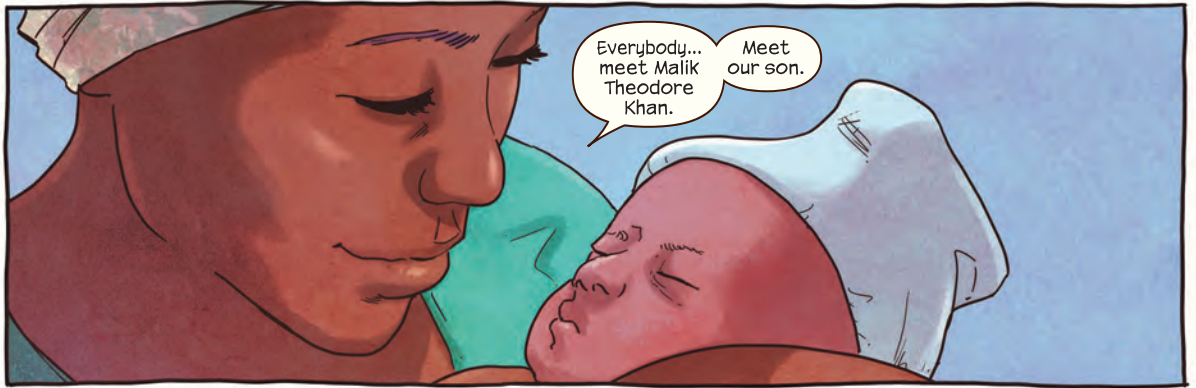

Yay, baby!

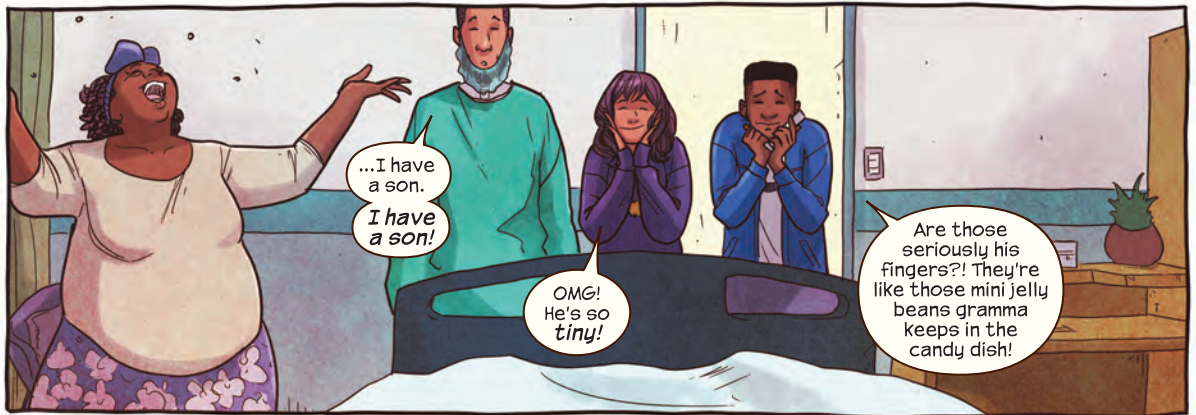
Tyesha! My love! Are you still alive?

Subhan Allah.


A brand-new, unrepeatable human being...and we're his family. Us. His *whole* life is our responsibility.

We gotta do right by this little guy.


