






Archie and his pals 'n' gals were small screen icons long before Riverdale made its historic debut on televisions across America in 2017. In 1968, The Archie Show, a cartoon produced by Filmation introduced thousands of new fans to the red-headed teen and his group of friends. Archie and the gang then appeared in a number of spin-offs produced in the same format through 1977. After making a splash outside of the comic pages, the Archie crew took a break and returned back to form—that is, until the late 1980s. In 1987, Archie got a bit of makeover (and a trip back in time!) before returning to television. The New Archies, produced by DIC Animation City, was originally created for NBC's Saturday morning schedule and reimagined the characters of Archie Andrews, Betty Cooper, Veronica Lodge, Jughead Jones, Reggie Mantle, and other students of Riverdale High School as preteens in junior high, with a few notable changes and additions: Dilton Doiley, for one, did not appear on The New Archies, and was replaced by a new character named Eugene. Eugene's girlfriend Amani was also introduced in *The New Archies*, as was Archie's dog, Red.

The show was such a hit that Archie Comics produced an identically named and themed comic book that ran alongside the animated series—and it's from that series and its spin-off, *The New Archies Digest Magazine*, that we've collected the following fun and hilarious stories for your reading enjoyment. So get ready take some wild trips and witness some junior high hijinks with The New Archies!
