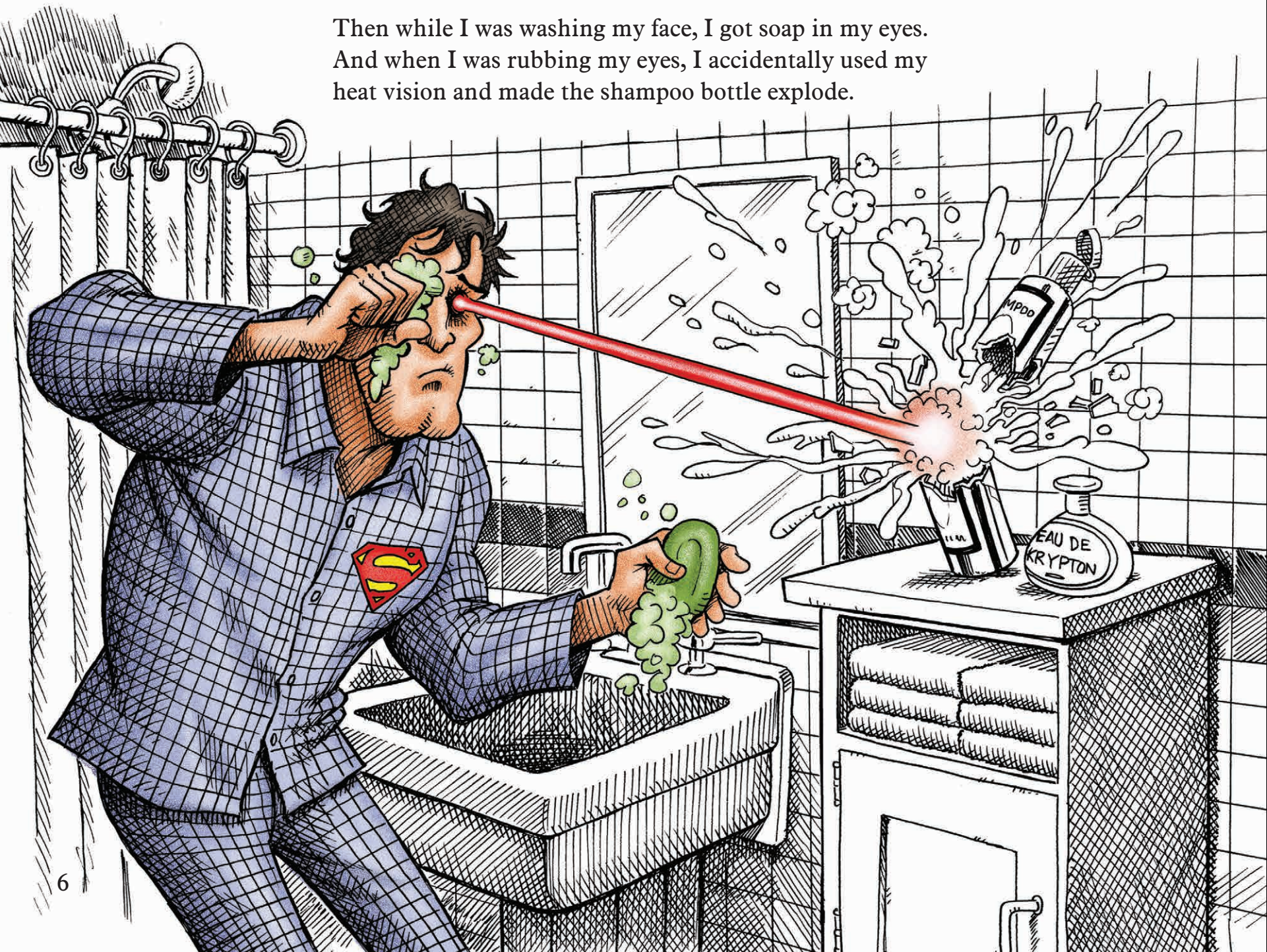
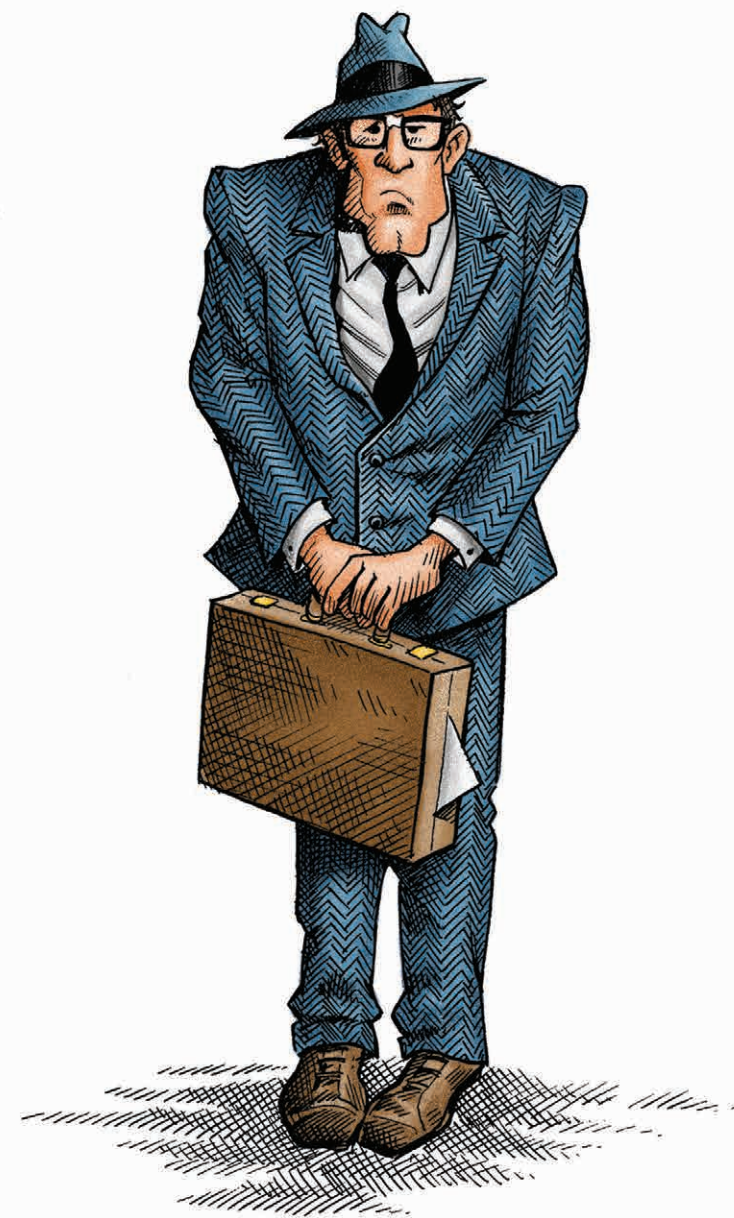


Then while I was washing my face, I got soap in my eyes.

I'm just going to move to the Fortress of Solitude.



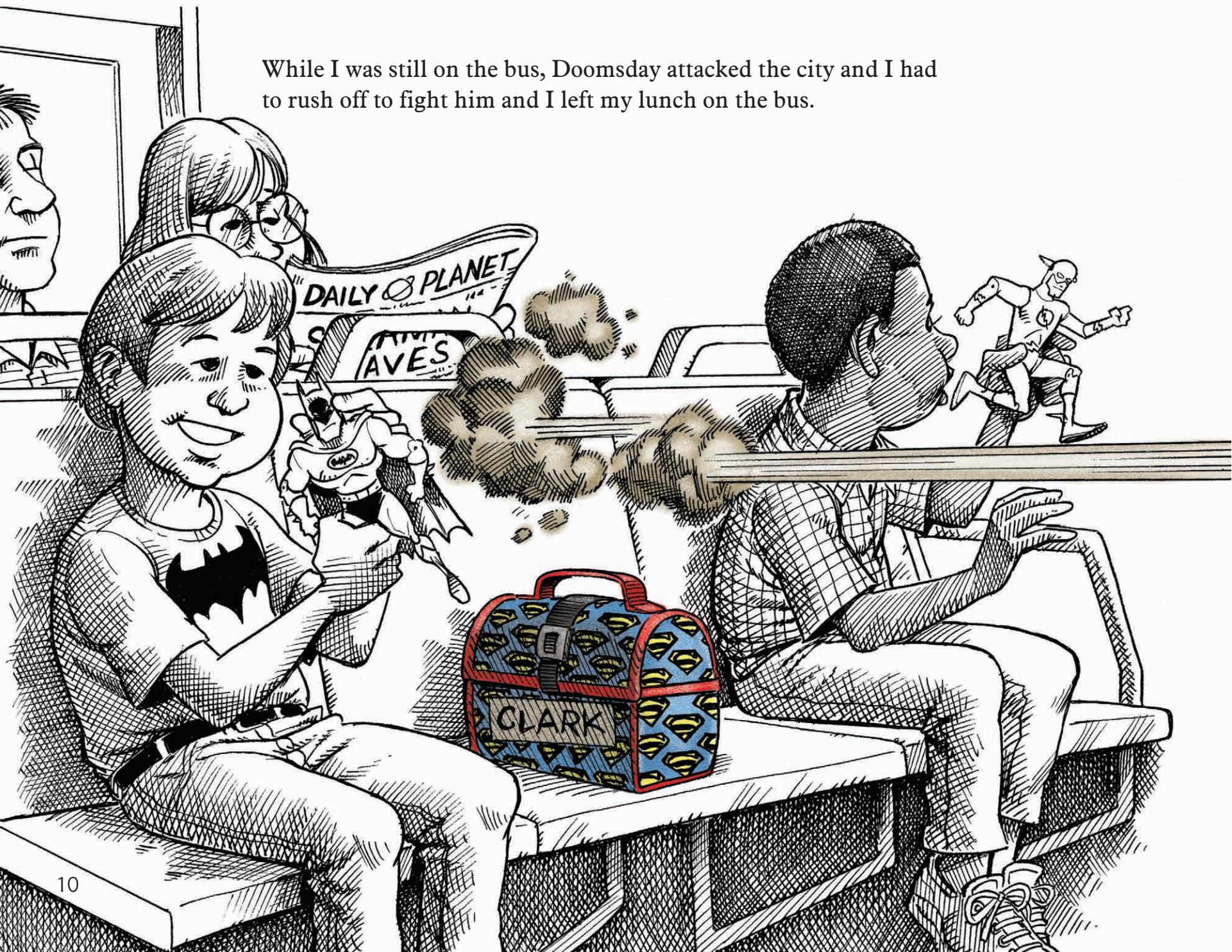
