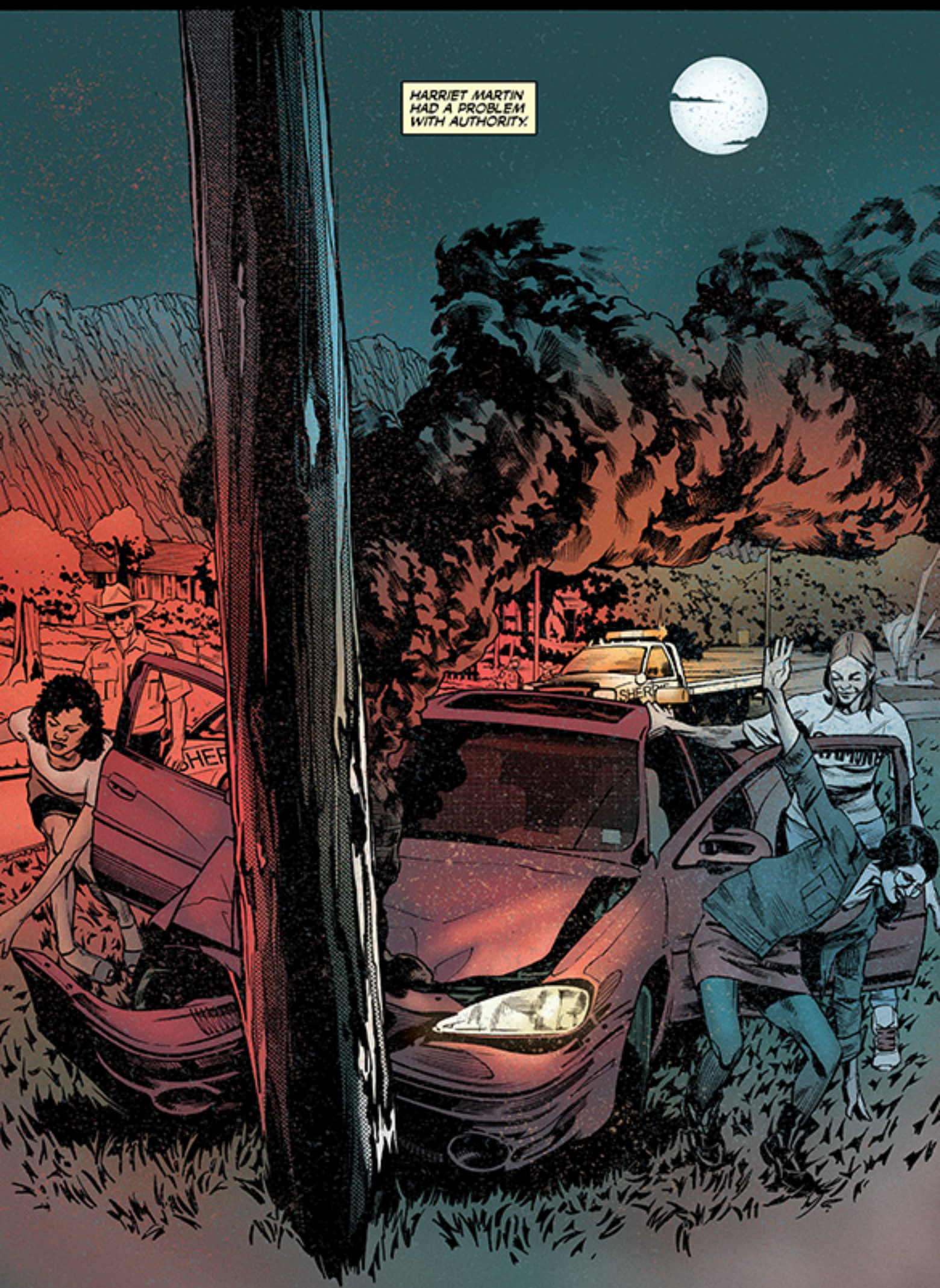


HARRIET MARTIN
